PAYMENT:

Non-refundable deposit AU\$1000.00 due 15 April 2020 with completed & signed booking from. ***Travel insurance is recommended once you have paid your deposit.***

Non-refundable second deposit AU\$1000 due 01 June 2020

Final payment is due no later than 03 August 2020 – AU\$/US\$ rate to be advised by organisers

Singapore Airlines is closely monitoring the development of the Coronavirus situation.

As at today's date 15 Feb 2020 Delhi has not been declared a "no go" zone. If at any stage Delhi is declared a "no go" zone and the tour has to be cancelled you will receive a full refund of airfares. If you cancel voluntarily there will be no refund.

Cancellations due to circumstances other than the Coronavirus is a separate issue.

Cancellation Land content portion of tour –

Prior to June 15 the portion paid will be fully refunded

June 15 – 1 September - 80% of the portion paid will be refunded

1 to 8 September - 50% of the portion paid will be refunded

September 8 – 15 - no refunds

Tour cost is based on a minimum of 10 photographers travelling. If the group size decreases the cost of the tour will be re-assessed and negotiated. The tour operator also has the right to cancel the tour and monies fully refunded.

In the event that the tour itinerary changes or the tour is cancelled due to circumstances outside of the control of the organisers (such as war, threat of war, riots, terrorist activities, civil disturbances, industrial disputes, natural and nuclear disasters, adverse weather conditions, hurricanes, floods, unavoidable technical issues with transport, epidemic, pandemic and similar) the organiser will not be liable. No compensation, payments, expenses or any sums, including the cost of securing alternative accommodation or flights will be paid by the organiser.

AIRFARE CONDITIONS:

Minimum group size 10 passengers travelling together on the same itinerary.

If the group size does not reach the minimum number of 10 passengers by April 1 the tour will be cancelled.

Stopovers are permitted (passengers' cost) at Singapore in each direction. Stopover bookings must be made prior to tickets being issued.

Passengers travelling from different Australian cities will meet at Singapore to connect with the group for the flight to Delhi.

After Ticketing – AU \$200 per person fee applies EACH TIME there are any changes to the ticket, such as reissuing the ticket, incorrectly spelt name and deciding to stop in Singapore will apply. Your passport will be required.

Upgrades to business class can be arranged on an individual basis

INSURANCE

It is strongly recommended that you take out comprehensive insurance cover against any cancellation, medical expenses, personal accident, loss or damage of personal baggage/belongings, money and public liability before you travel.

The best time for buying your insurance is when you are paying the tour deposit. Please advise your Travel Insurance Company, policy number and ensure you have your policy details with you on tour should it be required including emergency contact phone numbers

VISAS & PASSPORTS

A valid passport is required for travel to India. Your passport must have no less than 6 months validity from date of return to Australia. It is your responsibility to make sure that you have obtained your Indian Visa before leaving Australia. Assistance can be given in applying for your visa.
